A subject pronoun is the subject of the sentence. It comes before the verb.

OBJECT PRONOUN

An **object pronoun** is the object of the sentence. It comes **after** the verbs.





SELF IDENTITY

Who am I?

Have you ever wondered, "Do Freally know myself?" or "Who knows me best?"
Before you start trying to understand others, it would be better to understand yourself first.

It is the understanding of your own characteristics. Knowing things such as your favorite color and what food you like and dislike is very important in trying to know yourself better,

e.g., I am emotional, I feel happy when I eat ice cream, I want to be an entrepreneur.

Why is it important?

Think of self-identity as the fingerprint of you as a person. Recognize what makes you unique and separates yourself from other people. It can help you strengthen your character and set the boundary in how others treat you (e.g., you know that you dislike being lied to. So, you can stay away from people who often tell lies).



How?

- Identify your personality—How you act, think, and interact with your surroundings. You may try the 16 personality online test that is available for free.
- + Observe your feelings—How you react emotionally when faced with certain situations.
- + Find a role model, someone who you can look up to—It can be real people or fictional characters from movies or books. It does not always mean that you have to be exactly like them, but you can draw inspiration from them, in a positive way, of course.
- Ask your close family members and friends about what they think about you—Sometimes, you need to see yourself from other people's perspective.
- + Know your core values—Figure out the things that are important to you. Your value will affect

- most of your thoughts and actions (e.g., you value loyalty; therefore, you will never betray other people).
- + Reflect on your past—You may learn some lessons from your past (e.g., you used to love pop music, but now you prefer classical music because you have taken an interest in composing classical songs).
- + Look forward to the future—Knowing what kind of person you want to be will help you in determining your course of actions toward achieving that goal.
- + Allow yourself to try new things—It may help you discover different types of experiences that are actually fulfilling for you.

After you have recognized your self-identity, live as yourself without trying to emulate other people. After all, the original is almost always better than the copy!


