This is my bathroom! This is my favorite room! I can sing in the bathtub. I love the golden yellow tiles. Just like the color of my feathers!




This is my backyard; Zoey's Garden! I take care of my plants here. I feel calm and happy. This is the patio. There are tables and chairs!

Now I'm starting to miss them!


