Sammy always comes into my bedroom and plays with my things!

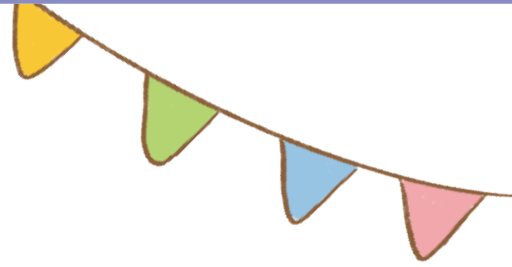
One time, Lola was wearing my favorite tutu and Sammy spilled his drink on it!

A house is not a home without my family!





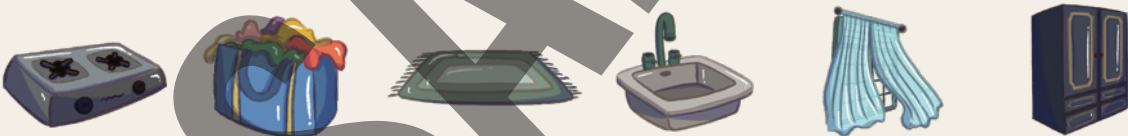
